Research call 2018

ESPN board announced a call for research proposals on pediatric kidney disorders. The aim of the call is to stimulate collaboration between pediatric nephrologists in Europe and to promote clinical or basic projects pertinent to children with renal disorders.

Applications should come from a member of one of the ESPN working groups or should be presented as a collaborative project of one of the ESPN working groups.

The applicant should complete the attached form and submit it electronically to <u>espn@espn-online.org</u>.

Closing date for submission: April 30, 2018

The applications will be evaluated by the independent reviewers and by the ESPN board on the basis of merit, scientific excellence, and relevance for the field. Successful projects will be funded to a maximum of 20 K \in .
