### 50th Anniversary Meeting of ESPN, 6-9 September 2017

50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Meeting of ESPN will be held in Glasgow on 6-9 September, 2017. The theme is "What have we learned in the past 50 years and where will we go in the next 50 years?" The scientific program is online and includes state-of-the-art plenaries, several joint sessions with other societies (ESPU, ERA-EDTA, and EWOPA). Each of the 7 ESPN Working Groups will present on the past, present and future for their area. There will be a separate Young Paediatric Nephrologists' session.

Moreover, an exciting social program is awaiting you in Glasgow.

Abstract submission has just ended. Deadline for early registration is 15th June 2017!

#### Capturing the history of paediatric nephrology in Europe

Heather Maxwell (Congress President), Richard Coward (Chair Scientific Committee) and Martin Christian (Chair Local Organizing Committee) would be grateful if you or your local colleagues could interview past members about the past 50 years of ESPN. You can locate and conduct video interviews with retired European paediatric nephrologists and patients in the 1970s. #### IPNA -ESPN Master for Junior Classes

<u>2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle 1<sup>st</sup> IPNA –ESPN Master for Junior Classes</u> will be held in Glasgow – Scotland, September 5-6<sup>th</sup> 2017 (just before 50<sup>th</sup> ESPN Annual Meeting). The program will comprise the first year of the masterclass syllabus.

This IPNA-ESPN educational program is especially dedicated to Pediatrics residents, Pediatricians with special interest in Pediatric Nephrology, fellows in Pediatric Nephrology and young Pediatric Nephrologists.

We will accept up to 50 applications. Deadline for applications is May 20<sup>th</sup> 2017. Please visit website for application procedure.

#### **Election for ESPN Council**

Six ESPN Councilors will accomplish their terms (2014-2017). A candidate for Council may (with his written consent) be proposed in writing to the Secretary General (Elena Levtchenko) by any three members. Candidates have to provide a motivation letter indicating their choice of responsibilities (more than one responsibility can be chosen), curriculum vitae and letters of recommendation by at least three ESPN members. Deadline for applications is June 5, 2017.

Vacant responsibilities for the new Councilors will be as follows:

Education-CME, Young Nephrologist Platform, ESPN Council Communication/News Letter, Relation with National Societies for Paediatric Nephrology, World Kidney Day, Organizing Website Content, and Liaison function to one of ESPN Working Groups.

We are currently working on "electronic voting system" which will be used for the Election of the Councilors.

### **Candidates for IPNA Council as ESPN Representative**

In 2017 there is one vacant position for ESPN in the IPNA Council.

Candidates can apply by writing to *the <u>ESPN Secretary General</u>* and by providing their motivation and Curriculum Vitae. Deadline for applications is June 5, 2017. The decision will be taken by the ESPN Council.

### **Bids for ESPN Congress 2020**

Bids for ESPN Congress 2020 can be submitted to *the Secretary General* and will be voted during the ESPN General Assembly meeting in Glasgow. Deadline for applications is June 5, 2017.
