## **ESPN Annual Meeting 2015**

The 48th ESPN Annual Meeting is approaching: 9 weeks left for our Annual Meeting which will be held in Brussels, September 3-5, 2015. The carefully prepared scientific program is online and includes state of the art lectures, symposia, oral communications and guided poster sessions. Moreover pre-congress educational courses, master classes, special sessions for junior attendees, and an exciting social program are awaiting you in Brussels! In addition to the established partners of the ESPN such as IPNA and ERA-EDTA, the congress will present new sessions in collaboration with ESPU and ICCS (European Society of Pediatric Urology, International Children's Continence Society) and industry sponsored symposia.

Early Registration deadline expired on June 15, 2015. But, you can still save if you <u>register</u> <u>before August 20, 2015</u>; thereafter you will have to pay onsite registration fee.

Before the Congress, on September 1 and 2, <u>the Second ESPN/IPNA Master for Junior Classes</u> will be held in Leuven-Belgium. The scientific program is already available <u>online</u>.
